Meeting Highlights

- MOU update: The group reviewed comments from the lawyer for Solano Irrigation
 District and approved or revised them. Chris Lee of Solano GSA sent out another copy of
 the MOU with those changes, and asks that the collaborative review them and comment
 by 8/30.
- **Update from LSCE:** Vicki Kreitszinger of Luhdorff & Scalmanini Engineering showed two maps to the group, a <u>geologic cross-section map</u> along Putah Creek, and a <u>map of wells monitored regularly</u> in the Solano subbasin.

- Map #1: She answered questions about what the map shows (details about the area it represents and the data on the map itself), and sections in the GSP where it will appear.
- Map#2 is a map of wells with regular monitoring across the Solano subbasin, from the 1920's-40's to 2014.
 - Vicki learned that 23 wells had been removed by DWR for a variety of reasons, and is now in the process of looking into getting the data back and what that would entail.
 - It was decided that she would connect with John Curry, who might be able to provide useful contacts and information.

GSA updates:

- City of Vacaville hasn't yet heard definitively about annexation changes, will update everyone when they do.
- Sacramento County: Linda Dorn attended an RD3 meeting and brought back information that they are considering leaving the NDGSA. The group discussed and shared information about what they might choose instead, including sharing info about costs now, as well as estimated they have heard for the costs associated with Annual Plans and Five-year Updates.
- Community Engagement Plan: Genevieve Taylor of Ag Innovations sent out the <u>Community Engagement Plan</u>. Please provide your comments by Sept. 9 for review at the 9/16 meeting.
