MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

- 1. Members agreed that an upcoming meeting should include a discussion on estimated annual implementation costs. These would include administrative costs, funding the well monitoring network, Annual reports and updates to the GSP.
- 2. Luhdorff and Scalmanini Engineering and Kennedy Jenks offered a summary of key areas of work on Solano GSP development including incorporating Collaborative comments on draf GSP Section 2; current efforts on the monitoring well network; and GSP section 4 development.
 - a. The deadline for input on each GSAs current and projected future land use has been pushed back to January 29th in order to integrate the presentation from Duncan MacEwan on land use trends.
- 3. Duncan MacEwan, ERA Economics, gave a <u>presentation</u> on Solano Subbasin land use trends as well as an overview of considerations for projects and management actions based on 2020 GSPs.
- 4. Luhdorff and Scalmanini Engineering have created an initial list of potential projects and management actions for this group to review.
- 5. Ag Innovations gave an overview on the concept under consideration for the Interbasin Coordination Forum focused on Projects and Management Actions and received input on the concept from members. Collaborative members recommended keeping the Forum to a half day event and focusing it on Solano Subbasins, it's adjacent subbasins, and possibly bringing in other subbasins with similar cultural and hydrological characteristics.
