MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

- GSA staff gave updates on their recent GSA Board meetings and the current status of GSP adoption. Solano GSA, City of Vacaville and North Delta GSA have all voted to adopt the GSP. Sacramento County GSA and SID GSA will be meeting next week to vote to adopt. Additionally, Reclamation District (RD) 2111 and RD 349 have submitted GSP adoption resolutions. RDs 3, 554 and 556 are anticipated to submit adoption resolutions in the next week.
- 2. Members discussed next steps in clarifying GSP implementation fees for the subbasin. ERA Economics will be developing a draft cash flow model that will summarize the expected GSP implementation costs between 2022 and 2040, as well as an associated finance plan that will include options for recovering costs.
- 3. The GSP technical team, led by Luhdorff & Scalmanini Engineering (LSCE), gave a number of updates including, finalizing the GSP for submittal to DWR, compiling data for the subbasin's Annual Report (due April 2022), preparing for DWR's AEM Survey in Solano Subbasin, and the installation of three monitoring wells along Putah Creek, with more planned to go in in early 2022.
- 4. Jenn Fox, Ag Innovations, gave an update on the January 10, 2022 Community Advisory Committee (CAC) meeting. All Collaborative members are encouraged to attend this final meeting of the CAC. The meeting's main goals are to support CAC members to understand the process around implementation fees at a high level, get member's input on outreach and engagement into implementation, and to acknowledge the great work of members and appreciation of their input throughout the GSP development process.
